

Annual Report of BASM

The main purpose of BASM is to take short, medium and long-term plans to increase the financial literacy among the market intermediaries, and existing and potential investors in the capital market of the country. BASM has also got the mandate to arrange training sessions, certificate programs, diplomas, postgraduate courses, and other courses depending on the requirement expressed by the commission.

Activities of BASM during July 2022 – June 2023

01. For 2022-2023, a total of 74 training programs were designed, keeping 2 for investors and 1 for Authorized Representative in each month of the academic calendar. However, because of increase in training hour for investors(from 6 hours to 12 hours) and authorized representative (from 15 hours to 32 hours), the number of training courses for investors and authorized representatives was reduced from 42 (24 + 18) to 22 (14 + 8). We successfully conducted almost all predetermined training programs on time, excepting training on Corporate Governance, which could not be conducted for lack of participants. Moreover, training on Compliance of Securities Markets Rules and Regulations were conducted 6 times instead of 4 times (as planned for 2022-23). Proposed and actual implementation of training programs during 2022- 23 has been shown in annexature-01.

02. In addition to training, BASM organized workshops/seminars during 2022-23. One online seminar on Investor's resilience and Sustainable Finance was organized by BSAM under the guidance of BSEC on the occasion of World Investor's Week. Two seminars were organized on Monetary and Fiscal policy and a number of discussions on incorporating Investors Education related issues in primary and secondary level academic curriculum were held during this period.

03. Outside the purview of academic calendar, BASM undertook many other activities (annexature-02). Notable among those, two foundation training programs of one month/90 hours duration for BSEC Officers and Assistant directors were organized. As a part of country wide dissemination of Investor's Education, BASM organized 4 investors Education Conference in Mymensingh, Sylhet, Bogura and Noakhali during 2022-23.
